

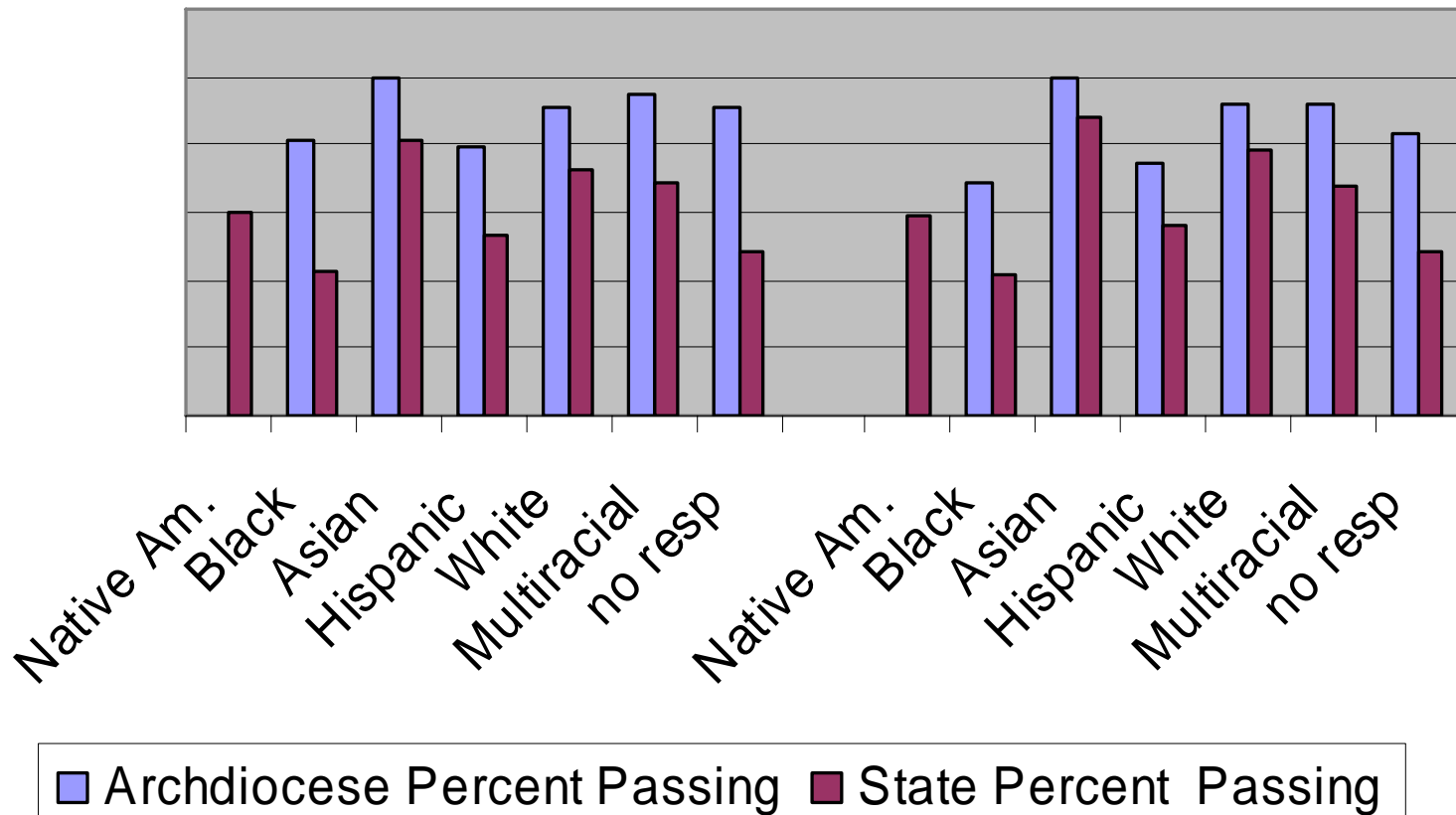

- Ten percent unsubsidized

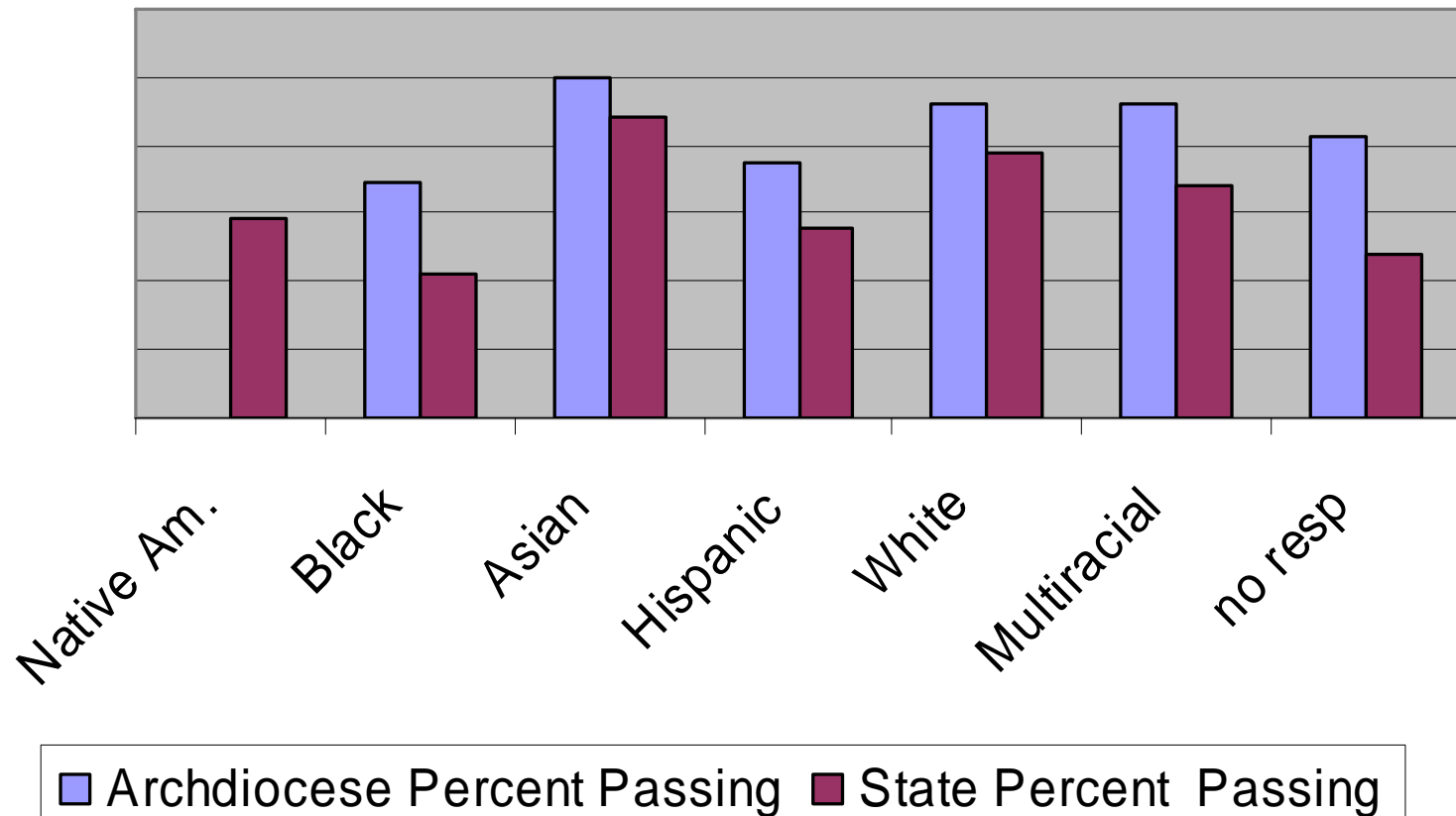

2004-05 Archdiocese and Indiana 8th-grade ISTEP English/Language Arts



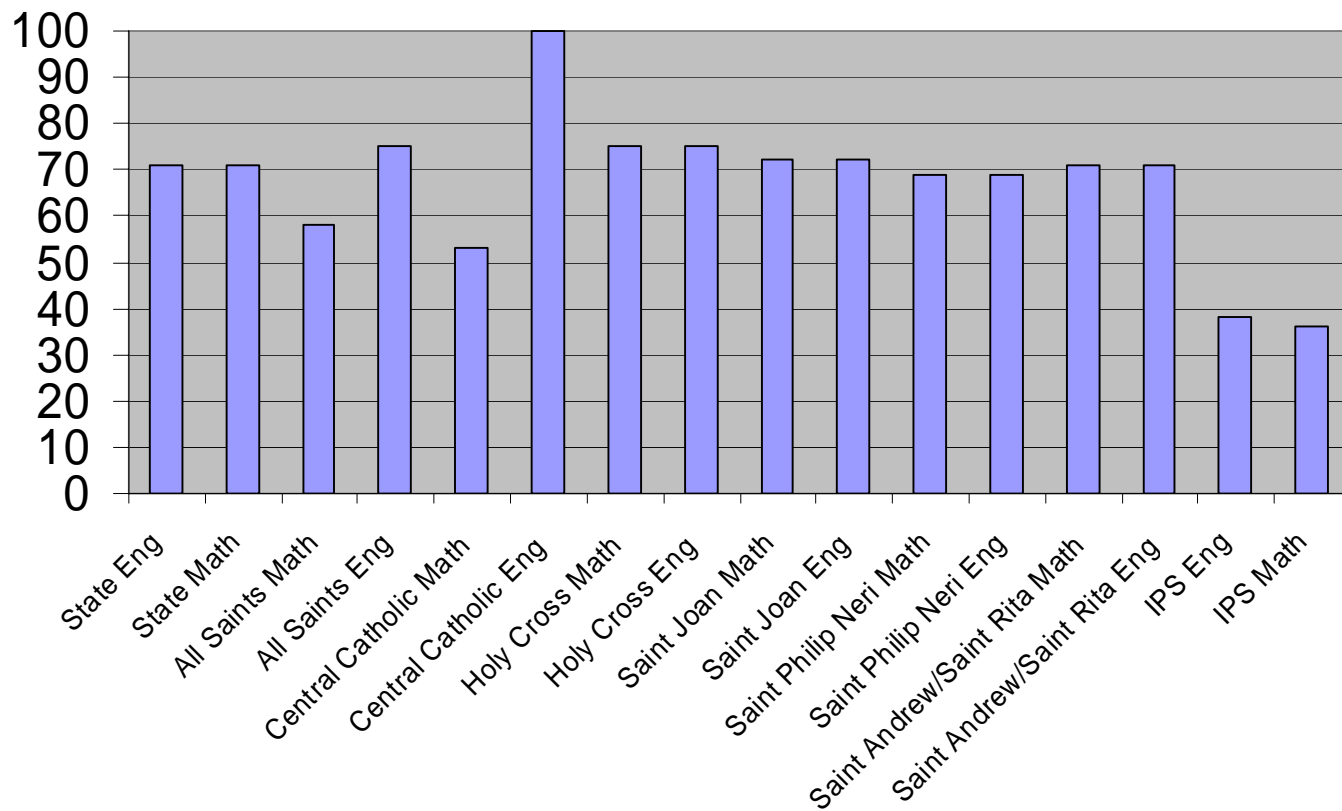

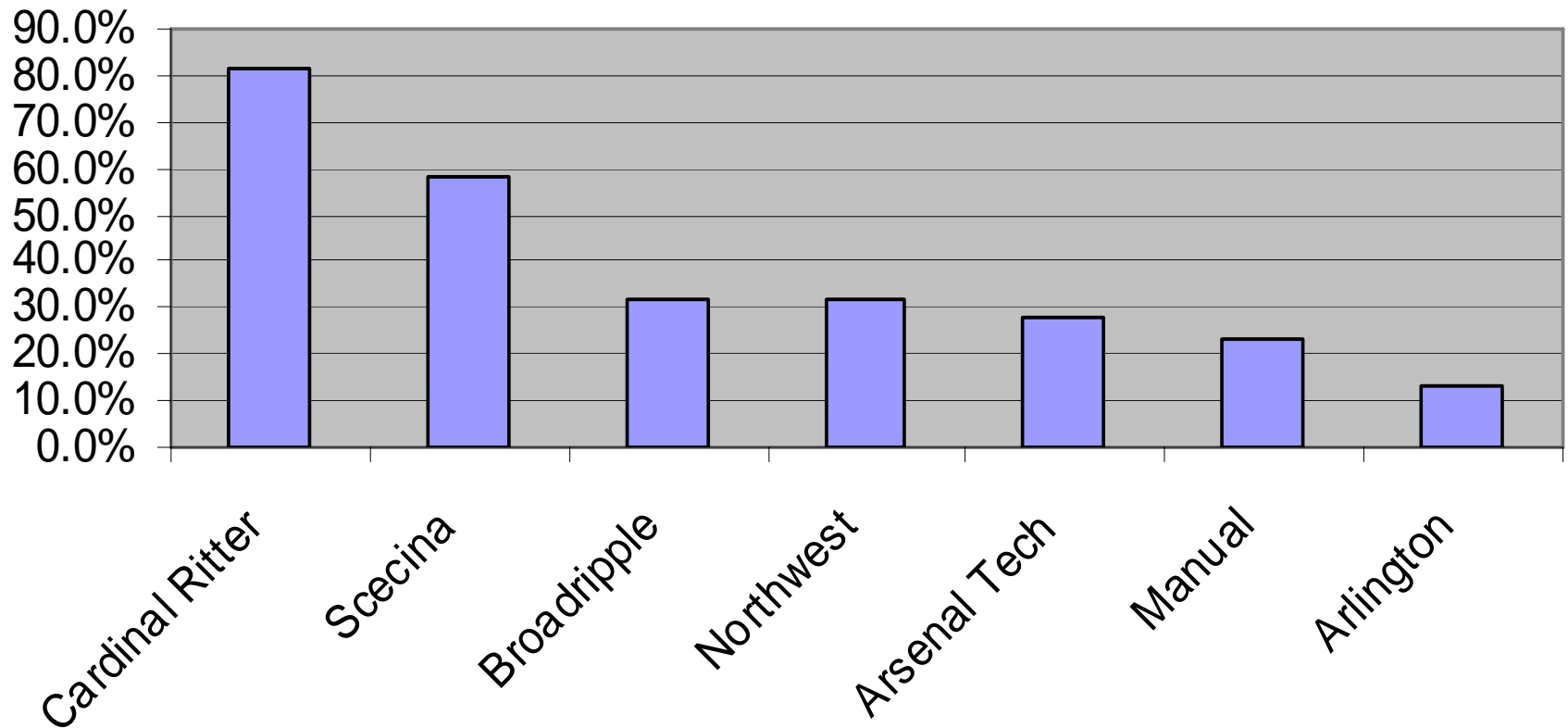

2003 8th Grade ISTEP Passing Rate Comparison

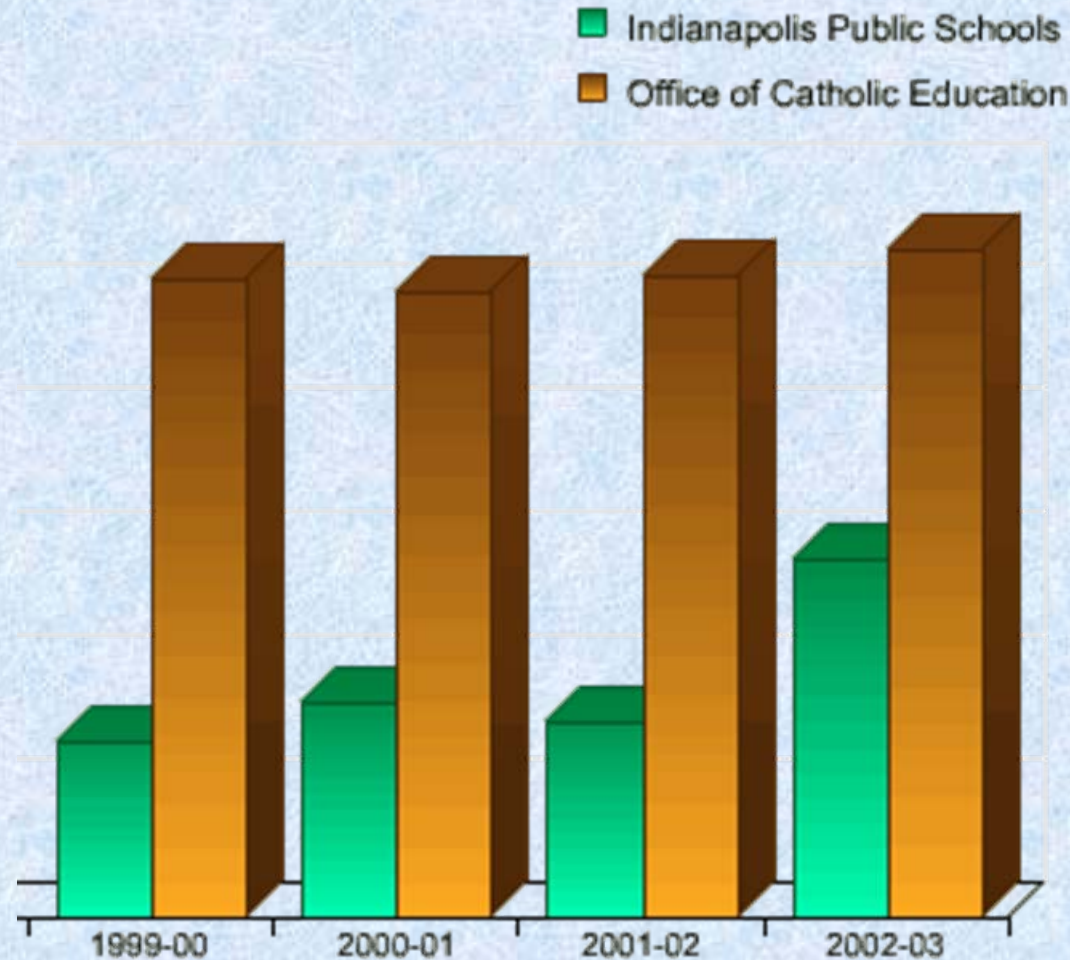


The Story: Indianapolis High School Graduation Rates

2004 Graduates as a Percentage of Ninth Graders Four Years Earlier

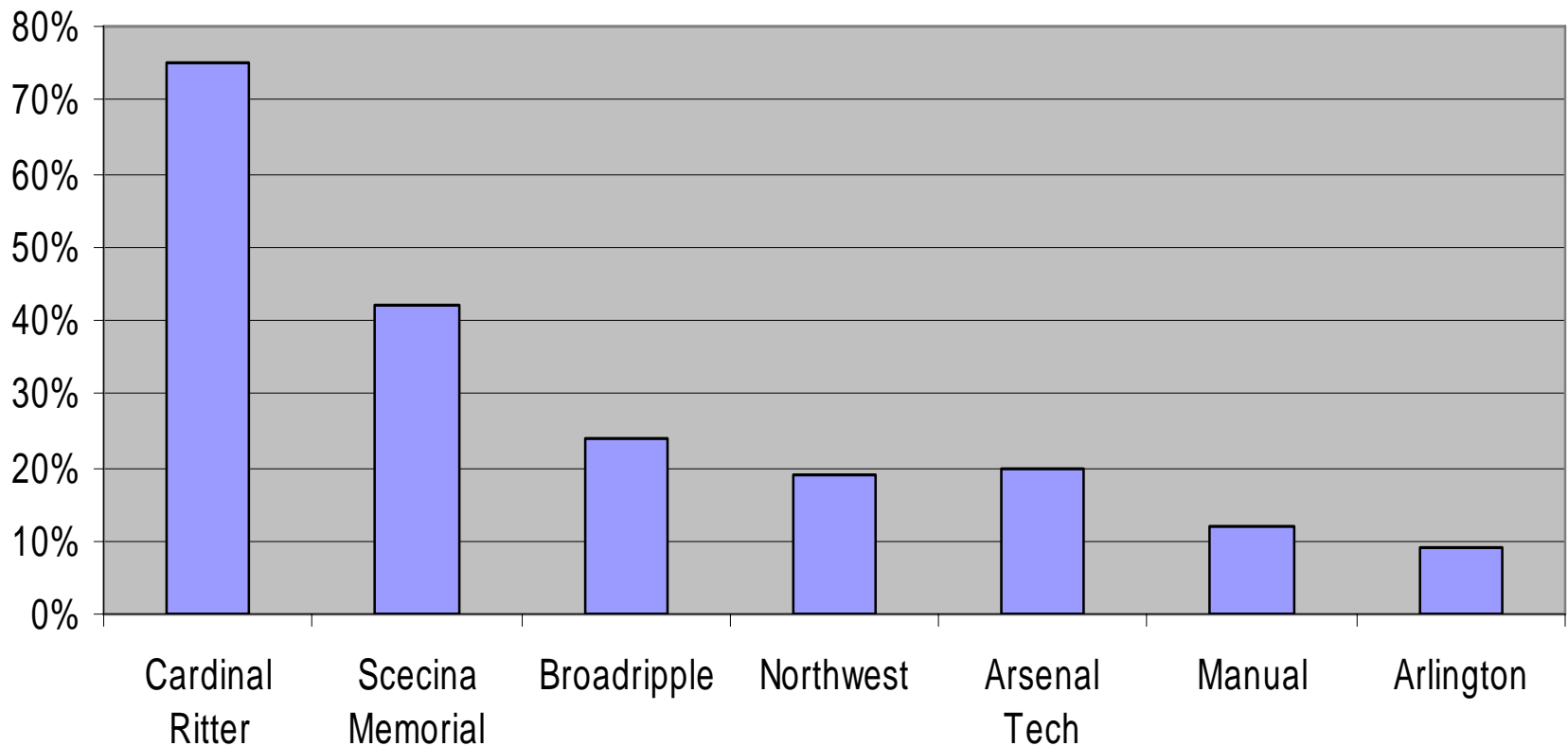


The Story: Catholic and Public Counterparts High-School-to College Continuation Rates

The Story: Percentage of Entrants Who Will Pursue College – IPS and Center City Catholic High Schools

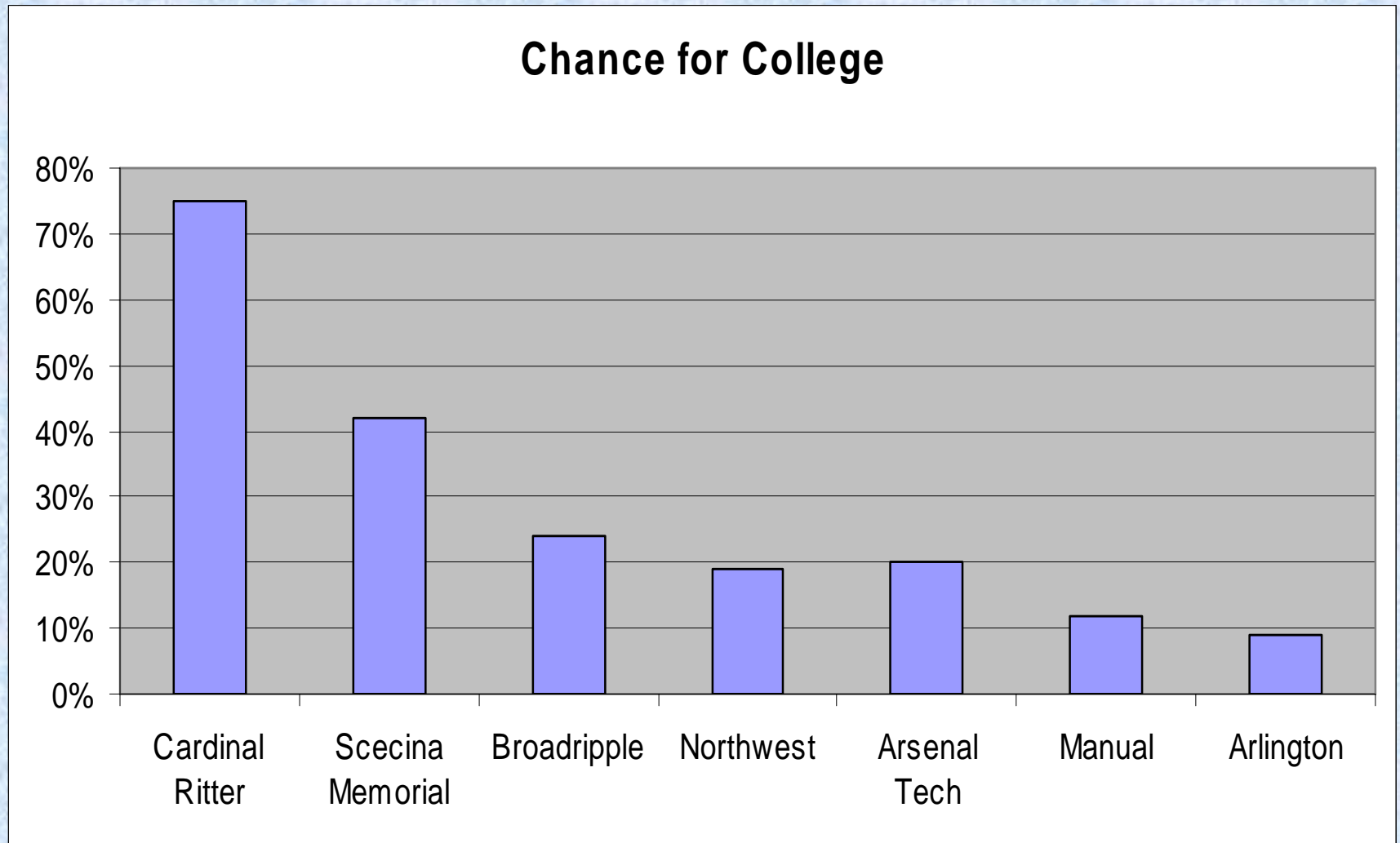
Formula Chance for College by Age 19 =

Graduation rate x College Continuation Rate

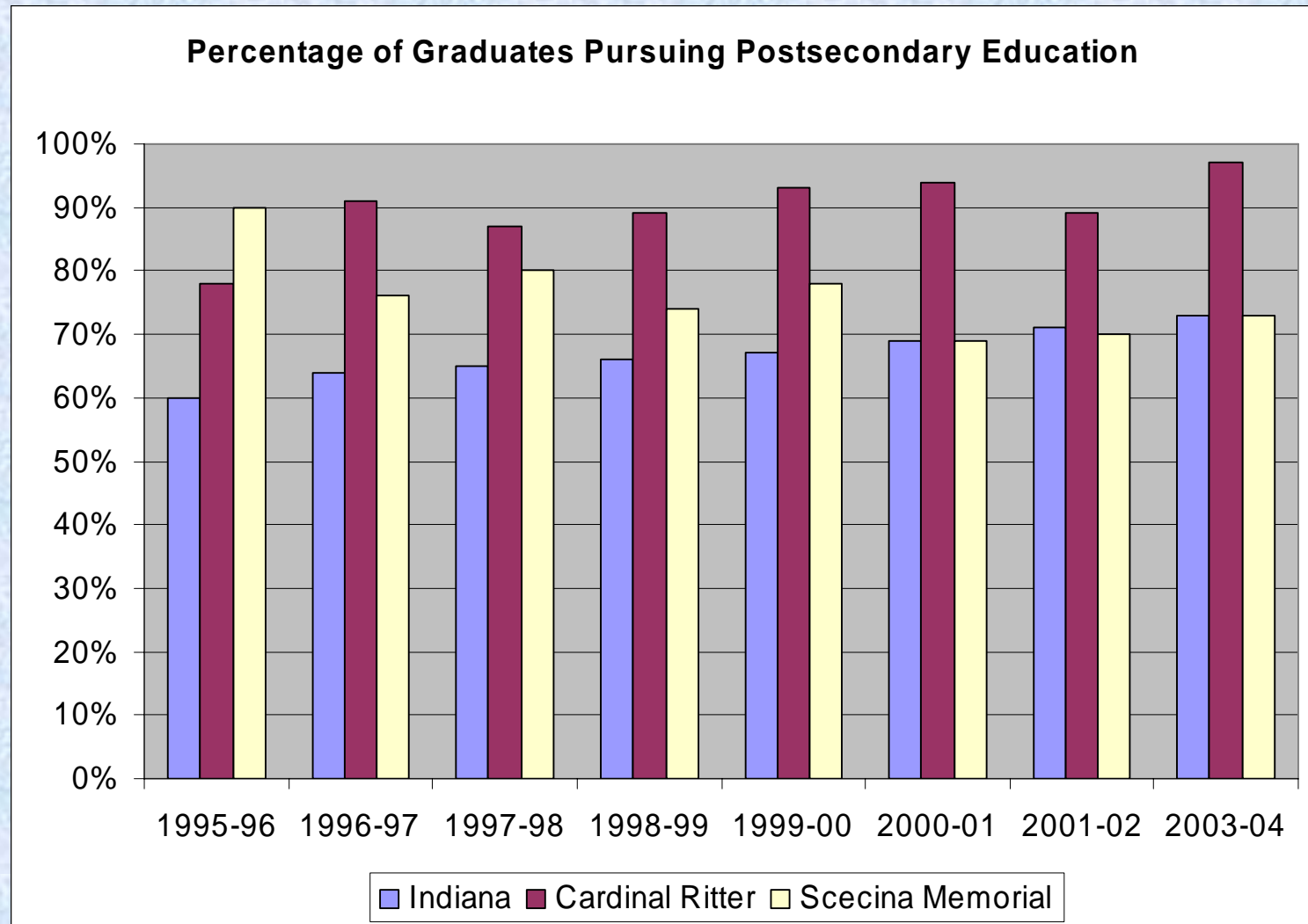
Example: 68 percent of students graduate and 62 percent of these pursue postsecondary education...

Yields **42 percent** Chance for College (most recent rate for Indiana)
